- Vendor application
- Must submit liability Insurance. Additional insured Name of Organization shall read, "City of Stockton, Visit Stockton and Child Abuse Prevention Council, their officers, officials, employees, and volunteers." \$1M per occurrence, \$2M aggregate.
- Mandatory attendance at a Zoom orientation meeting (covering rules and expectations)
- Must have a pre-approved carnival game for family engagement (please note: prizes for all games will be supplied)
- Bring your own tents
- Table and 2 chairs will be supplies
- Set up by 9:30 am on May 14th, no exceptions
- Cannot tear down till after 3 pm on May 14th.
- Share Flavor Fest Social Media content 1x per week April 1st thru May 14th (content will be supplied)
